She is presently pursuing her Masters in Fine Arts (Choreography) at the University of North Carolina-Greensboro, where she is a Graduate Teaching Fellow in the Dance Department. 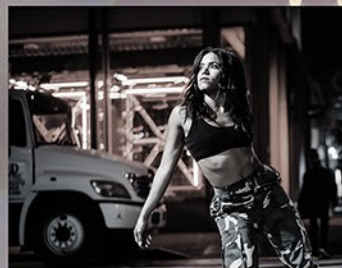
ELIZABETH ANDREWS
